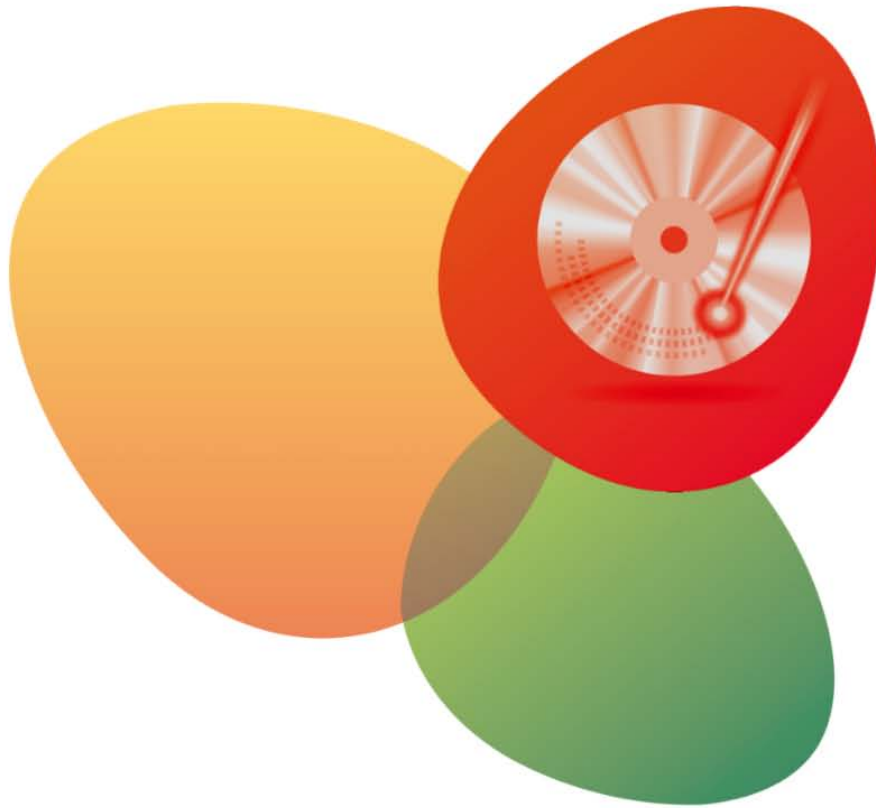

## Creating a Cover With Nero CoverDesigner

In this tutorial you can follow the step-by-step procedure for creating a cover with Nero CoverDesigner :

When you start Nero CoverDesigner, the **New Document** window is automatically opened along with the main screen. This window is your starting point for creating a new document. You can also open the window with the icon on the toolbar in the main screen.

To create a new cover in Nero CoverDesigner, proceed as follows:

1. Click the **Standard symbol**.
2. Select the **Bubble\_Blur** template from the **Audio** tab.
3. Click the **OK** button.
  - The **Document data** window is closed.
4. Click in the **Title** text field and enter the desired title.
5. Click in the **Year of release** text field and enter the desired date.
6. Click in the **Artist/Publisher** text field and enter the desired text.
7. Click the **Apply to all subitems** button.
  - The information will be applied to all elements in the document.
8. Click on the element **Audio/Chapter data** in the document tree.
9. Click the Add Track button multiple times
10. Click the **Add Track** button multiple times, to add the required number of tracks.
11. Add additional track information:
  1. Click on the desired Track, for which you want to store additional information
  2. Click in the desired text field, and enter the desired information.
  3. Click on the **OK** button after you added all desired information to the tracks.
    - You added additional track information.
  - Click the **OK** button.
  - The **Dokument data** window is closed.
12. Select the elements you want to edit from the **View** menu.
13. Double click the track list to edit it.
14. Change the desired settings.
15. Click the **OK** button.
  - You created and designed a new cover.
